PURPOSE

The purpose of this scholarship program is to recognize and assist a student, or number of students, who desire to pursue, after successfully completing high school, a course of study related to a "degree" in a field of logistics at one of the states technical colleges or trade schools. This includes programs in:

- Transportation
- Facility maintenance management
- Vehicle maintenance management
- Warehousing
- Contracting
- Plant management
- Shop management
- Distribution systems
- Energy management
- Drafting and Design

Other skills and trades related to facility maintenance

The program is further designed for students who want to pursue technical/career education programs at one of the states technical colleges or trade schools leading to "certification or diplomas" in:

- Electrical/Electronics technology
- Heating ventilation and air conditioning
- Construction technology
- Ornamental horticulture
- Welding

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

1. Be scheduled to graduate from high school with a technology/career education diploma during the year scholarship application is submitted.
2. Have a minimum overall course average of 2.0 (C) in related vocational field.
3. Be accepted as, a full time student, into an accredited technical vocational college or trade (acceptance letter to be included as part of application) in the state of Georgia.
4. Acceptance requires a course of study related to the purpose statement.
5. Course of study must lead to degree, diploma or certification.
6. Candidates for this scholarship must be actively enrolled, and on line to graduate, from a school system that has active representation in the Georgia Association of School Facility Administrators (GASFA)

Amounts

The scholarship program will award in the amount of \$500.00 to a student pursuing a degree and \$500.00 to a student pursuing certification/diploma.

Students pursuing a "degree," or are in a program that requires more than 12 months to complete under full time enrollment status, may apply for the scholarship annually.

CANDIDATE SELECTION

All applications will be reviewed by a panel of judges consisting of:

Executive Director
Association President
Directors

Each judge will review the documentation and prioritize all applications. The priority will be established based on a grading system which will include:

1. Applicant's overall grade point average (transcript required) with emphasis in related technical/career education field.
2. Minimum of two "Letters of Recommendation" (prefer one from an administrator and one from a vocational instructor).
3. A narrative from the applicant indicating rationale for pursuing the course of study selected.
